## Services

The Huble Homestead historic site is open 10:00 - 5:00 every day from the May long weekend to the September long weekend for guided tours, shopping in the General Store, and relaxing days by the river. Special events are held throughout the summer and the off-season. The office is open weekdays 9:00 - 5:00 and can help with general enquiries and historical information.

## History of the Society

Concerned citizens formed the HHGPHS in 1983 when there was a threat of the Huble House being moved. The regional park protecting the Giscome Portage was established in 1986, and after countless hours by dedicated volunteers the site was officially opened in 1989.

Since that time the Heritage Society has successfully restored several heritage buildings significant to the area.

The Heritage Society is a non profit organization governed by a board of directors. The Board is elected annually from the members.

Volunteers are needed on a continual basis throughout the summer for teaching and demonstrating heritage crafts, greeting visitors, food services, and work bees.
